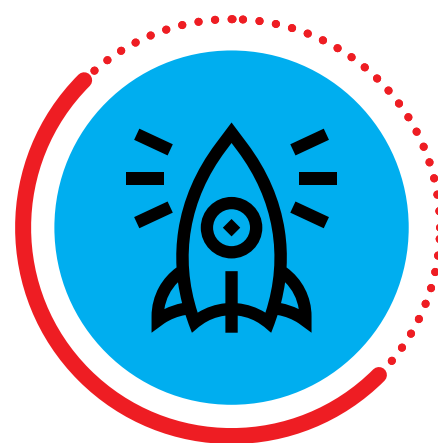
Preparation requires introspection. The Council on Higher Education's (CHE's) 'Institutional Audit as Reflexive Praxis' (IARP) is designed for introspection and preparation. Taken as a whole, the four focus areas and sixteen standards provide an avenue for individual and communal self-interrogation as a form of assessment and evaluation. The outcome of the UKZN IARP will determine whether our quality management systems will reveal our institution as:



01 NON-FUNCTIONAL



02 NEEDS SUBSTANTIAL IMPROVEMENT.



03 FUNCTIONAL



04 MATURE.

Under the new QAF in 2024, the CHE will continue its focus on qualifications whilst institutions judged as mature would approve their own programmes that lead to qualifications.

The working groups are still collecting information from all of us, in a bottom-up mode, consistent with reflexive praxis.
